#### Canon Niall writes.....

Welcome to this week's newsletter. This Seventh Sunday of Easter, falling between the Ascension and Pentecost, has a feel of moving the focus of the Risen Jesus in just one body, to his presence in the lives of all his people through the Holy Spirit. In the Gospel of St John today, from what is known as Jesus' priestly prayer; he prays for his followers, that all the Father gives to Jesus, might be alive in them, and that by their lives, the life of God that was made present in Jesus, may be present in them. He prays that they be 'One Body'. The 'Body of Christ' is not just one person, but by the Gift of the Holy Spirit, we are the 'Body of Christ' in the here and now. We come to the Sacraments so that the life of Jesus may be strengthened in us, and that we may believe that we can be his living presence. In our world of today, with the concerns of divisions, conflict, climate change and the growing gap between rich and poor, nations thinking only of their own interests, that loving, caring presence of Jesus is needed more than ever. This time, amid all the concerns, uplifts us, and reminds us that every one of us, whoever, or whatever, our situation can allow that presence of Jesus to be real, alive and present in our lives, and that as the 'Body of Christ' show that care of God in our world

The mere fact that personal, family and community habits are changing is contributing to greater concern about the unfulfilled responsibilities of the political sectors and indignation at the lack of interest shown by the powerful

**DO JUSTICE** is an invitation to parishes to become a more synodal & missionary Church, a Church that adores God & serves the men & women of our time, going forth to bring everyone the consoling joy of the Gospel. The sessions will run across the next two Monday evenings, 13th & 20th May, at 7pm in Our Lady's, Birkenhead. Each of the sessions will begin with a short time of prayer. The sessions will use the Synodal Method established by Pope Francis.

<u>St Michael's Old Presbytery:</u> Work is restoring the Old Presbytery at St Michael's is coming to completion, but it will a short while yet until the building is ready for use again.

Changes to the Abortion Law and the threat of abortion up to birth: Members of Parliament will be voting possibly on Wednesday, 15<sup>th</sup> May, or another date not too far off, on two amendments to reduce the limit of abortion time from 24 to 22 weeks, and another amendment to reduce the abortion time limit for babies with Down's syndrome to the same as other babies. At present abortion for Down's syndrome babies is up to birth. Also MP's will have the opportunity to vote on two amendments that will generally give the right to abortion up to birth.
