Deanery Support: This weekend with Father Michael Coughlan away, Father Sam will be covering Masses in St Paul's, Beechwood and Our Lady's in Cavendish Street. Again, this is a time when we help each other as a local Church.

Solemnity of All Saints, Friday, 1st November: This coming Friday, 1st November is the Solemnity of the All Saints and is a Holyday of Obligation. Because Father Michael is away, Father Sam and I are looking after ours and Holy Cross, Our Lady and St Paul's Parish. The Masses available on the day of the 1st November, are a 9.15am Mass at St Michael's, also a 9.15am at St Joseph's, a 12.noon Mass at Our Lady's, Cavendish Street and a 7.00pm Evening Mass at St Joseph's. Just to remind you, that the obligation to attend Mass is for those who have the health, means and ability to do so.

Middle East Humanitarian Appeal - CAFOD: The Disasters Emergency Committee (DEC) have launched an emergency appeal in response to the worsening crisis that we see in the Holy Land. CAFOD is a member of the DEC. Thanks to the support of the Catholic Community here in England and Wales, they have already been supporting partners providing essential and life-saving responses to the huge need in Gaza to many thousands of people over the last year and have been able to allocate £60,000 out of core funds to Lebanon partners to support their immediate response. Livestream at St Michael's: We are very aware that the Livestream at St Michael's has been down for a good period of time, and we are very sorry about this. This is not a problem with the Livestream itself, but with the Wifi connection on the whole St Michael's Site, which has turned out to be a very complicated issue. We are working as best we can to get a solution as promptly as possible.

For the past few years, we have joined with Holy Cross and the Methodist Church to take part in the Halloween Share the Light Prayer Walk (Thursday 31st October). It is a very informal walk of witness for the estate; we walk around giving out glow-sticks and offering prayers if people are interested. Otherwise we just let people know we are from the churches. The plan is to meet at the Methodist Church on Pemberton Road at 5pm, prayer and go around the estate for about an hour. Arrive back around 6pm ready to go a different way around until 7pm. If anyone would like to join us, please dress for the weather and meet at the Methodists at either of the times.

<u>St Michael's Church Cleaning</u>: This Thursday 31st October after the 9.15am Mass. All help greatly appreciated, thank you.

<u>Security at St Michael's Church and Site:</u> With the new CCTV and security measures now in place at St Michael's this is improving the situation. Thank you all and please continue to take care.

Children's Liturgy at St Joseph's and St Michael's: In the next few weeks we hope to be in a position to reintroduce Children's Liturgy at St Joseph's and St Michael's. As soon as we have definite dates we will let you know.

<u>St Michael's Old Presbytery:</u> The work to repair the flood damage is now completed and in the immediate days coming we are working to get the building ready for use again. Hopefully this will not be much longer.

<u>Churches Together:</u> In Saint Joseph's church we are praying this week for those in the following roads: Elm Rd, Elmswood Rd, Ennerdale, Fairways, Holborn Sq, Holly Grove, Holt Hill & Holt Rd.

<u>Candle Stands:</u> Just a reminder, please place the wax candle cone in the glass cup and then light it with the lighter provided. Please do not light the wax cone candle before putting it into the cup. The figure of '£1' is only a suggestion; whatever you are comfortable paying is fine.

LIVERPOOL WELSH CHORAL present: Fauré: Requiem and Gounod: Saint Cecilia Mass, Christ Church Port Sunlight, <u>Saturday 9th November - Just six months after filling</u> Liverpool Anglican Cathedral for a stunningly dramatic performance of Verdi's Requiem, Liverpool Welsh Choral come to the Wirral to perform two very different Mass settings, both by French composers. Instead of the thunderous *Dies Irae* of the Verdi Requiem, Fauré's Requiem includes hauntingly beautiful settings of the Pie Jesu and In Paradisum. Rather than equating death with judgement, and retribution, Fauré viewed death as: 'a happy deliverance, an aspiration towards happiness above, rather than as a painful experience' The Fauré is preceded by Gounod's Saint Cecilia Mass, a little known but charming work, appropriately performed in the month when we celebrate the feast of St Cecilia, patron saint of Music. A number of singers from the Wirral sing with Liverpool Welsh Choral, described by one reviewer as 'simply dynamic!'. They deserve to be heard!
