<u>Changes to regular times over the Christmas</u> <u>Period:</u> Please note that some of the regular service time patterns will change of the Christmas period. On the Evening of the 24<sup>th</sup> December the first Vigil Mass of Christmas will be at <u>5.30pm</u> at St Michael's and the second at <u>10.00pm</u> at St Joseph's. On Christmas Day itself, 25<sup>th</sup> December there will be a 9.30am Mass at St Joseph's and an 11.00am at St Michael's. On <u>Thursday 26<sup>th</sup></u> December, St Stephen's (Boxing) Day there is a 10.00am Mass at St Michael's and on Friday 27<sup>th</sup> December a 10.00am Mass at St Joseph's.
