Canon Niall writes.....

Welcome to this week's newsletter for the Fourth Sunday of Lent. Some of the Religious Teachers of that time criticised Jesus' approach, he: "receives sinners and eats with them". So Jesus told them the story of a son, who took his father's money, wasted it on riotous living, and then came back to his father asking to be given a job as servant! However, his father welcomes him back and lays on a feast for him, much to the annoyance of the older son, who has worked hard for his father and has worked hard and never asked for anything! This older brother thinks his father is being unjust. His father comes and pleads with him, he wants this hard working son to share his vision, to share his heart and love, and see feel and act with his heart. To be glad with him and be happy his brother is home, to share in the father's love. This was Jesus' challenge to the Religious Teachers; he wanted them to share God the Father's love, to reach out to those in need 'the sinners' so they could be welcomed back. Those Religious Teachers lived 'good' lives, but almost felt 'God owed them a reward'. Jesus is inviting them to 'share in the vision of God the Father' and as they have received his gifts, so share them with the generosity of God who gives them. In this time of Lent we are invited to stand back, see any hardness of heart in ourselves, and in receiving the gift of God's love, pass it on and live it so that others also can be reached to and welcomed. When we seek to do this, we are sharing in the vision and heart of God

Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and enkindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created. And You shall renew the face of the earth. O, God, who taught the hearts of the faithful by the light of the Holy Spirit, grant that by the gift of the same Spirit we may be always truly wise and ever rejoice in his consolation Through Christ Our Lord. Amen.

<u>Mothers' Day:</u> We pray for all our Mothers on this special day, those who are living and those who have gone before us, and we specially remember them in our prayers.

The Marian Lamp: burns each week in both our churches for particular prayer intentions. This week the Lamp in Saint Joseph's burns for **Tom Anderson.** The Lamp in Saint Michael's burns for **KK Varghese** 6th **Death Anniversary.** Please write your intention out and place it with an offering (we suggest £5 to cover the cost of the candle) in an envelope marked "Marian Lamp". We ask Our Blessed Lady to carry these prayers to her Son and to intercede for us.

<u>Youth to Lourdes</u>: Some of our Parish Youth are going as helpers to Lourdes with the Diocesan Youth Pilgrimage. To help towards the financial cost of going they will be organising some fundraising events starting with a raffle for a chocolate hamper and other prizes. When someone wishes to see a Priest, or receive spiritual support in Hospital: Just a repeat of last week's note; whilst for the time being there is not a Catholic Chaplain based in Arrowe Park Hospital, there is always a Priest 'on call' 24/7. This cover is from the Priests of this, and our neighbouring, Deanery. If someone, whilst in Hospital, needs to see a Priest urgently, please speak to the Nursing Staff and ask them to call the 'On call Catholic Priest'. This is the best way to get someone over as quickly as possible, rather than 'ringing round' Clergy you know, as this can cause delays and mixed messages. If you, or someone you know, is in Hospital, and would like to receive Holy Communion or general visit which is not urgent, please contact me, Canon Niall, or ask for the Church of England Hospital Chaplain to contact me, and I can arrange for someone to call.

Mass Intentions situation: Once again, thank you for the number of Mass requests we are receiving. If a specific time and date has been requested we will do our best to accommodate these. There are rules which guide us in offering Mass Intentions which have been received with a 'Stipend', a financial offering, as for example, when there are two requests for the same time and date, then we are obliged to offer the one received first, and offer the second as soon as possible. Also every Parish Priest is bound to offer, or cause to be offered, a Mass every weekend for the 'People of the Parish', the Mass you will see as 'Parishioners' in the list. If it seems to be taking a while for a Mass you have requested to be offered, please we ask your understanding as we offer these according to the correct practice.

Easter Activity for Children: Maundy Thursday 17th April at 5pm in the Raiswell room at St Joseph's. Preparation of Hot cross buns, the story they tell, followed by Children's liturgy on Good Friday when the children will bring their Hot cross buns to church at 3pm. A list will be put at the back of Church for names. Parents must stay with their children.
