Canon Niall writes.....

Welcome to this week's newsletter. This weekend we welcome Pope Leo XIV as our new 'Chief Shepherd'; it is providential that this is 'Good Shepherd Sunday'. I will say more about Pope Leo inside; as I say though, on this Fourth Sunday of Easter the Gospel is always one of the versions of Jesus, the 'Good Shepherd'. Jesus used the image of 'sheep' and 'shepherd' a lot. In Jesus' earthly time, as would probably still be the case in many places in the middle east today, shepherds pastured their sheep together. These sheep from being tiny lambs, would have been taught their shepherd's distinctive call; they would recognise their shepherd's call alone. At the end of the day, when several flocks had been pastured together, the shepherds would stand outside the flocks and each make their distinctive call; the larger flock would then separate and each would go to their own shepherd only, and follow him only to their own corral. Jesus watched this process, and thought in a way it was like our world; there are so many 'voices' that call us 'this way & that', and it difficult to recognise what is true. That is why we come to Mass, take time to pray and seek to live our Christian life, so that being 'attuned' to God's way we will recognise, amid all the 'voices', the voice of Christ the Good Shepherd and with his grace, follow it. This is a day when we pray for 'Vocations'; and we pray that we may each recognise our 'call' and by following it, help build up the Body of Christ today.

Prayer to the Holy Spirit – please pray this prayer every day

Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and enkindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created. And You shall renew the face of the earth. O, God, who taught the hearts of the faithful by the light of the Holy Spirit, grant that by the gift of the same Spirit we may be always truly wise and ever rejoice in his consolation.

Welcome to Pope Leo XIV!: On Thursday Evening we welcomed the news that Cardinal Robert Prevost, originally from Chicago in the USA and working for a great deal of his ministry in Peru, had been elected as our Pope, in succession to Pope Francis. Cardinal Prevost took the Papal name 'Leo' and is now the fourteenth Pope to hold that name. Pope Leo was created a Cardinal in 2023 by Pope Francis, and worked closely with him. In his emotional greeting to the Church on Thursday he prayed for peace, and to build bridges in the spirit of Pope Francis. As I mentioned on the front page, it is a message of hope that Pope Leo's first Sunday as Pope is 'Good Shepherd Sunday' when we reflect on our response to the call of Christ, our Good Shepherd. We pray with Pope Leo, our new 'Chief Shepherd' we will seek with him to follow the call of Christ, and go forward together with him as the Body of Christ today.

As we have mentioned, there is deep concern about this Bill, not just in the Church or Faith circles, but in society as a whole. The Bishops' Letter urges us once again to write to our MP expressing concern and asking them to vote against this Bill.
