Canon Niall writes.....

Welcome to this week's newsletter. This weekend's Gospel has St Matthew's version of 'The Beatitudes', the attitudes that are shown forth in the life of one who believes in Christ. 'Blessed' means to be rooted, like a well-grounded foundation stone, that stays firm, and supports and gives strength to the building upon it, no matter what batters it. The 'Beatitudes' are the values that a Christian is 'grounded' in. All the values reflected there are the fruit of a living relationship with God and shown in the person's attitude and outlook to others, and actions in the world. The Old Testament prophet Zephaniah speaks, in troubled times, of the example of those who are rooted in God and help share hope and new vision for others. In a time when we are aware of so much suffering in our wider world and others struggling nearer to home, those values, those 'Beatitudes' are needed more than ever. When there is hate, violence, warfare and division that show such a cruel face, the values of love, mercy, compassion, tenderness, peace and justice show the face of Christ. St Paul reminds us in the second reading that God's ways challenge, and almost 'turn upside down' the values of the 'world'. Today, as we meet Jesus in Word, Sacrament and each other, we take heart and courage, that every one of us, whoever we are, and whatever the circumstances of our lives, can show that 'face of Christ' in our outlook and attitude, and be a living sign of hope to those around us

Prayer to the Holy Spirit – please pray this prayer every day

Come O Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and enkindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created. And You shall renew the face of the earth. O, God, who taught the hearts of the faithful by the light of the Holy Spirit, grant that by the gift of the same Spirit we may be always truly wise and ever rejoice in his consolation. Through Christ Our Lord. Amen
